The minutes of the Regular Meeting held on March 5, 2014 were presented to Council and read. Michael Franklin made a motion to accept the minutes as read. The motion was second by Mike McNulty. Vote: all-yes, motion carried.

Richard Heilman made a motion to pay the bills as presented. Joshua Mitchell seconds the motion. Vote: all-yes, motion carried.

Josh Martin from Eastwood Baseball and Softball Association informed council that clean up date is scheduled for April 5th. The Opening day parade is scheduled for April 27, 2014 at 1:00 P.M.
